SelectFlorida International Leadership Mission to Italy

Keith Norden was honored to accept the official invitation to participate in the SelectFloirda International Trade and Business Development Mission to Italy, led by Governor Ron DeSantis. The mission took place November 10-16 and focused on key tracks including trade, foreign direct investment (FDI), universities, ports, and space, targeting high-growth industries such as marine, aviation and aerospace, life sciences, and manufacturing.

The Governor was joined by several high-ranking state officials including Chief Financial Officer Patronis, Secretary Kelly, Secretary Weida, Secretary Perdue, Secretary Byrd, as well as prominent Florida companies, universities, hospitals, Space Florida, Florida Ports and select Economic Development Organizations (EDOs). Volusia County representatives included Keith and Embry-Riddle Senior Vice President and Chief Operating Officer Rodney Cruise.

The itinerary featured visits to Rome, Viareggio, Florence, Turin, and Milan. SelectFlorida Business Seminars were organized in each city with programs highlighting each of Florida's high growth industry sectors. During the five-day mission, industry sector tracks split off into specialized meetings to optimize the time and resources.

The mission provided an array of opportunities to meet with top level Italian government and business leaders, with a focus on corporate decision makers. Local participation during the mission activities including seminars, roundtable discussions, and business activation events/receptions were at the highest level due to Governor Ron DeSantis and statewide leaders participating in the event.


