Spring Area Development Consultants Forum

The Spring Area Development Consultants Forum was held in Savannah, Georgia. The meeting brought together 250 participants from across the U.S. to discuss best practices and strategies with 25 of the nation's top site selection consultants. Keith Norden was pleased to represent Team Volusia EDC and have an opportunity to share the region's newly announced project locations and other exciting developments with the site selector community.



55th International Paris Air Show

Keith Norden attended the Paris Air Show which is held every two years outside of Paris, in Le Bourget. The largest in the world, the show included over 2,400 exhibitors from 48 countries, 155 aircraft demonstrations, 400 official delegations and 141,000 professional visitors.

The largest of any state, the Florida Pavilion and SelectFlorida's delegation of nearly 180 attendees featured 15 exhibiting Florida-based companies (including AO Precision Manufacturing, Daytona Beach), Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, Space Florida, and 27 economic development partners. The delegation was led by Governor DeSantis, who was joined by Florida Secretary of Commerce J. Alex Kelly, Florida Secretary of Transportation Jared Perdue, Florida Secretary of State Cord Byrd, Space Florida President & CEO Rob Long, University of Central Florida President Alexander Cartwright, Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University President Barry Butler, amongst others.

Aura Aero, the recently announced Toulouse-based company which plans to open manufacturing facilities and their U.S. headquarters location in Daytona Beach was an exhibitor and proudly opened the Paris Air Show with the first public flight of the three INTEGRAL aircraft, led by all-electric INTEGRAL E. Afterwards, Mr. François Bayrou, Prime Minister of France, visited their booth.

Prior to the show, the 4-state Aerospace Alliance (Alabama, Florida, Louisiana, Mississippi) hosted an invitation-only event for over 400 leaders from the aviation aerospace industry. Other business recruitment activities included a Florida Activation Event and Networking Reception hosted by SelectFlorida as well as a Florida Business Seminar led by members of leadership. These three activities provided an array of opportunities to meet companies with an interest in expanding to the U.S. and Florida.





Space Tech Expo

Space Tech Expo USA, held in Long Beach, CA, featured two conferences: The Space Industry and Space Technology. This year was the 13th edition with over 3,900 event attendees and 305 exhibitors. The event participation was broken down as follows: 55% with purchasing authority or influence, and 63% of visitors were from the C-Suite or Senior management. TVEDC's Tywan Arrington attended along with conference goers representing 31 countries, from 6 continents.

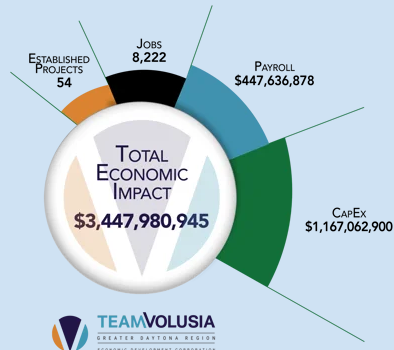


Team Volusia partnered with Florida Trend to create a multi-page business insert focused entirely on the Greater Daytona Region/Volusia County.

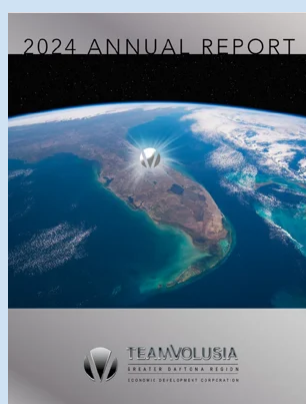

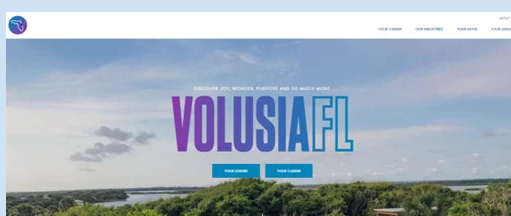
